





Employment Opportunity Nikani Awtiken - CAMP COUNSELORS

Nikani Awtiken is a program for Mi'kmaw youth ages 14-18 that provides rich cultural experiences, immersing youth in Traditional Mi'kmaw Knowledge and natural resource management, with the aim to foster deeper relationships with Wksitqamu. This year Nikani Awtiken will be hosted at Camp Rankin near St. Peters.

Nikani Awtiken is hiring Counselors for this year's program. You will need to be available for training days on July 30 and 31st, and then you will need to be available from August 1-8 days and nights.

Key Responsibilities:

- Participate in set-up/shut down at the beginning/end of the session;
- Daytime and night-time supervision of participants during all activities.
- Planning and implementing 'team-building' activities and organizing activities and games during the evenings;
- Participate in camp activities with participants, as a helper and guide;
- Ensure camp follows Nikani Awtiken Policies & Procedures (provided during training);
- Be available for the entire eight days of camp, and two training days before camp.

Personal Requirements:

- Strong communication and interpersonal skills;
- Experience working with youth; Strong ability to effectively facilitate conflicts;
- Able to supervise people during set activities and downtime;
- Must be highly motivated; Must have professionalism and integrity;
- Knowledge of Mi'kmaq culture and language is an asset;
- Background checks are required for successful applicants.
